Total expenditures: \$123,486

Details of expenditures

Duchity Organization for Vocational and VolunTour Experience (DOVVE):

\$60,029 for construction and operation of the school

Vocational education was provided with classes in English, Computer, Agriculture, Construction, Plumbing, Tile and Welding. The teachers' salaries were supported. Government taxes were paid. Equipment and supplies for classes were obtained. Construction of the buildings continued, especially on an essential new workshop.

Water purification:

\$18,878 for biosand filters

Ninety new bio-sand water filters were purchased and installed in homes and clean water education provided. There were 118 follow up visits made. The technicians attended a continuing education course. With each filter being able to serve 10-20 people, this program served up to 1,800 people this year. At the end of 2016 there were 25 families on the wait list for a filter.

Hurricane Matthew relief:

\$41,278 for emergency supplies and rebuilding

Emergency supplies were purchased and distributed including food, tarps, soap and bleach. Water tanks were set up for the community. Materials were purchased for repairing buildings, such as metal roofing, lumbar, rebar, sand and cement. Labor and transport were paid for. Seeds were purchased. Instruction was given about cholera. Five disaster-resistant buildings were successfully constructed using the innovative technique of a Vermont engineer under his guidance and instruction, and the panels were completed for two more.

Primary education:

\$700 for supporting primary school teachers' salaries

Transportation:

\$560 for replacing truck axels and renewing vehicle license

Administrative costs:

\$2,041 for annual IRS filing, bank transfer fees, wire fees, postage and phone calls
